

## Education Stations



The trails around Nalley Brown Nature Park will feature nine educational stations. These stations will feature displays and educational media that describe the integral ecological facets of the park. Subjects will include Trees, Soils, Geology, Water Quality, Birds, Insects, Mammals, Reptiles/Amphibians, as well as a Magnification station where some of the smallest yet most critical organisms in the park can be viewed. Not just for self-directed learning, these stations will also serve as outdoor classrooms. Each station will have secure cabinets filled with manipulatives and a curriculum specific to that station that teachers can utilize for group initiatives and focused learning. These stations will also be covered to provide emergency shelter during inclement weather and protect the displays from the elements.
